 - Sutherland shall provide the complete course material/curriculum for training in stored in Compact Discs (CD's) ;
 - Sutherland would offer the Communications Skills training (also called Training) free of cost
 - Sutherland's tried and tested training methodology would ensure smooth operations of the training program.
 - Sutherland shall provide assessment tools to help evaluate the performance of the students;
 - Sutherland shall nominate a training personal who would periodically supervise the training activity
 - Sutherland shall provide feedback to the College on individual performance of its students;
 - **Trainers** who are subject matter experts from Sutherland would conduct a "Train-the-Trainer" program for the nominated college staff free of cost.
 4. **COLLEGE'S CONTRIBUTION:**
 - 4.1 College shall promote its relationship with Sutherland and counsel students on the importance in participating in the proposed training program.
 - 4.2 College agrees to exclusively offer the Training to the students. The College shall not permit or offer any other program identical or similar to the Training through the services of any other BPO, person or entity during the MoU period.
