ANTI-RAGGING POLICY



Anti-Ragging Policy Coimbatore Institute of Management and Technology (CIMAT) (In Compliance with UGC Regulations 2009 & Amendments)

1. Preamble

CIMAT strictly prohibits ragging in any form, as defined under UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging (2009, 2013, 2016 Amendments). Ragging is a cognizable offense punishable by law, and CIMAT maintains a zero-tolerance policy to ensure a safe, inclusive, and respectful environment for all students.

2. Definition of Ragging

Ragging includes, but is not limited to:

Verbal/Written Abuse: Teasing, rudeness, or public insults (including via email/social media).

Physical/Psychological Harm: Forcing acts that cause shame, embarrassment, or trauma. Discrimination: Bullying based on caste, gender, religion, ethnicity, or socio-economic background.

Academic Disruption: Preventing freshers/juniors from attending classes or completing tasks.

Financial Exploitation: Extorting money or imposing undue expenses.

3. Anti-Ragging Measures

A. Anti-Ragging Committee (ARC)

4. Punishments

As per UGC Regulations, punishments include:

| Severity | Punishment |
|--------------------------|--|
| Minor Offenses | - Fine (₹25,000–₹1,00,000). |
| Wilnor Offenses | - Suspension from hostel/classes (1–4 weeks). |
| Maior Office | - Expulsion with academic blacklisting. |
| Major Offenses | - Criminal prosecution (FIR under IPC sections 294, 506, etc.). |
| Collective Punishment | Applied if perpetrators are unidentified (e.g., hostel suspension for entire batch). |

5. Student Responsibilities

Freshers/Juniors: Report incidents immediately to ARC/Helpline.

Seniors: Ensure a ragging-free environment; violations lead to immediate suspension.

Parents/Guardians: Submit affidavits (Annexure I & II) during admission.

6. Awareness & Prevention

Orientation Programs: Mandatory sessions on anti-ragging laws during induction.

Posters & Pledges: Display UGC guidelines across campus; students sign anti-ragging pledges.

Annual Audit: Review policy effectiveness via student feedback.

7. Grievance Redressal

Complaint Resolution: ARC resolves cases within 7 working days.

UGC Escalation: Unresolved cases may be reported to UGC Helpline (1800-180-5522).



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
